



Domtar Dryden Forestlands EMS Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Policy

It is a requirement for all Domtar staff, contractors and overlapping license holders that the following PPE must be worn at all times while working on the Trout Lake or Wabigoon Forests

- **Hard hat** - CSA/ANSI approved
- **Safety Boots** –CSA approved, green triangle, steel toed 8” height class which must be laced at all times and in good condition. NOTE: visitors to the field for short tours are encouraged to following this requirement, however on an exception basis this requirement can be waived
- **Reflective vests**, clothing or coveralls in good condition with reflective strips sewn in must be worn by all personnel when outside of cabs of vehicles/equipment. Reflective belts are not allowed
- **Safety Eyewear** - CSA approved safety glasses or CSA approved Prescription safety glasses with attached side shields are required on all Domtar license areas, ***The exception to this is for any EACOM CONTRACTOR working on the Trout Lake Forest. Safety glasses are not required unless the job being performed requires them***
